### **I. Approval of Minutes**

**On a motion made, seconded and carried, the minutes of the May 18, 2016 and the May 19, 2016 meetings were approved.**

### **II. Old Business**

**1. Hillside Terrace** - Request from Ms. Beth Kava to modify the existing parking regulation on Hillside Terrace from 1 hour parking, "7:30 AM to 6:30PM" to 3 hour parking, "7:30AM to 6:30PM".

She feels the 1 hour duration is too short.

*The staff has sent letters to the residents in the area and received some responses. The staff recommended that this item be held an additional month to allow more time for responses prior to making any recommendations.*

**On a motion made, seconded and carried, the Commission approved the staff recommendation.**

**2. Ridgeway** - Request from Mr. Steve Brady to create a "No Parking Any Time" on the north side of Ridgeway between Albemarle Road and Pilgrim Road.

*The staff has sent letters to the residents in the area and received some responses. The staff recommended that this item be held an additional month to allow more time for responses prior to making any recommendations.*

**On a motion made, seconded and carried, the Commission approved the staff recommendation**

### **III. New Business**

**1. Soundview Avenue** - Request from Dr. Garrett Weber to conduct a study of the area. Dr. Weber feels that motorists often speed on this road and does not feel that it is safe for pedestrians who are walking in the shoulder.

*The staff field reviewed the location. During the field review they noticed that the electronic speed display sign in the vicinity of Dr. Weber's home was obstructed by tree branches reducing visibility. A work order was prepared to trim the branches. The staff also noticed that only one speed limit sign exists on Soundview Avenue between Old Mamaroneck Road and Prospect Street coming into the City and two signs leaving the City. The staff felt that additional speed signs would be beneficial.*

*The staff also discussed possible revisions to pavement markings such as a white shoulder line to delineate an area for pedestrians and/or bicycles and possibly a double yellow centerline. The staff needs additional time to gather dimensions for the entire area.*

*Captain Kralik added that police have been enforcing in that area.*

**On a motion made, seconded and carried, the Commission approved the staff recommendation.**
