**Subject: Battle Avenue – Road Resurfacing
(Tarrytown Road to Whitney Street)**

Dear Owner or Resident:

The Department of Public Works (DPW) has awarded a contract to PCI Industries, Inc., for the above captioned work.

The resurfacing calls for a section of Battle Avenue between Tarrytown Road and Chatterton Parkway to be replaced in finished concrete pavement and will require the section to be **closed to through traffic**. The closure of this section will commence on or about Thursday, August 11th and last approximately three (3) weeks. Appropriate signage will be placed advising motorists of the closure and to seek alternate routes.

Preparation for the remaining road resurfacing (Chatterton Pkwy. to Whitney St.) will be performed simultaneously with the above mentioned work. This work will consist of minor curb repair, sidewalk pedestrian ramp installations and casting replacements. Once the preparation work is complete the road surface will be milled (removing the existing damaged road surface) and a new final top course of asphaltic concrete pavement will be placed. Travel lanes in this section will be managed utilizing appropriate signage, flag personnel and police officers. Access for residents, deliveries, refuse & recycling, buses, and emergency vehicles will still be provided for the roadway resurfacing work.

The work will be performed approximately between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. City DPW personnel will be on site to ensure the satisfactory performance of the contract. Although we will make every effort to expedite this work, please bear in mind that this is weather sensitive, and your patience and cooperation is essential and will be most appreciated.
