White Plains Launches GO GREEN Website

Going Green is a gradual process. It means becoming more environmentally aware and changing behavior and lifestyle to reduce the amount of pollution and waste you generate. White Plains has launched a new web page -- **GO GREEN White Plains** -- which details the City's ongoing environmental and sustainability initiatives.



Did you Know? - The City recycles over a thousand fluorescent light bulbs per year using a device called the Bulb Eater®, which safely and effectively crushes them into 55 gallon drums. When the drums are full they are sent to a recycling facility.

AT&T Building to be Repurposed as Apartments

A plan to re-purpose the former AT&T office building at 440 Hamilton Avenue, at the corner of North Broadway, has been approved. The building will be converted into an amenity-filled luxury rental residence.



Mayor Tom Roach said that the 245-unit apartment conversion, which includes 25 affordable units, is "The first, I hope, of many changes to Hamilton Avenue which will result in a more pleasant and livelier pedestrian experience and a more welcoming thoroughfare."



The plans call for the addition of a floor to the 12-story 1960's building as well as balconies, new landscaping and sidewalk improvements to enliven the 350,000 sq. ft. structure. Construction is expected to begin before the end of the year.
