That's The Continuum Rising at 55 Bank St.

You may have noticed a new building going up near the train station. This is The Continuum, located at 55 Bank Street. It's a 16-story residential building with 561 apartments, including 112 affordable units, and 6,000 square feet of ground floor retail.

At the City's request, the building will also include 200 new publicly accessible commuter parking spaces. Parking rates for these spaces will be the same as those in the city-owned TransCenter parking garage.



The exterior of the first of two buildings is almost complete. Interior work is ongoing. The first building is expected to be completed by the first quarter of 2018.
