HELP FOR AT RISK HOMEOWNERS

WHITE PLAINS, NY – October 23, 2017. Through a grant from the New York State Attorney General’s Office, the City of White Plains has partnered with Westchester Residential Opportunities (WRO) to provide outreach, education and counseling services to homeowners at risk of losing their home. These are residents who may be concerned about making their next mortgage payment, are in foreclosure proceedings, or are experiencing mortgage default. The purpose of this initiative is to help people stay in their homes and eliminate the creation of zombie homes that may become potential sources of blight in the community.

WRO is a U.S. Housing and Urban Development approved Housing Counseling Agency conveniently located in the City of White Plains. WRO specializes in providing education and counseling to homeowners at risk of losing their homes. There are special programs that have been created by the New York State Attorney General’s Office to help homeowners, and WRO can help facilitate access to them for at-risk homeowners. WRO’s counselors are highly skilled and trained to intervene in these kinds of cases.
