GENERAL: Under general supervision, incumbents perform a wide variety of skilled maintenance and repair tasks requiring knowledge of one or more of the building trades. Work involves the operation of trucks and motor equipment, and skill in the operation of power and mechanical equipment, electronic equipment and hand tools appropriate to the assigned tasks and trade. Work requires that incumbents may have to perform mandatory overtime and/or be called back to work any day of the week in response to special projects, emergency repairs or weather conditions. Supervision is not a responsibility of this class although assignments may involve working as a crew chief providing leadership over a project.

MINIMUM REQUIRED TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in the repair and maintenance of buildings, roads, grounds, facilities, structures, and/or equipment.

NOTE: Training gained by the completion of technical courses in a trade at a trade school, institute or branch of the Armed Services may be substituted for the above training and experience on a year-for-year basis.
