- B) *Bachelor's Degree in civil engineering or engineering technology and three (3) years of post-graduate engineering experience; or
- C) Possession of a Professional Engineer (PE) license issued by the New York State Department of Education.

REQUIRED: Possession of a license to operate a motor vehicle in the State of New York.
