**Downtown White Plains Wing Walk

**White Plains, NY - March 27, 2019.** On Saturday, April 6 there will be a little friendly competition going on in downtown White Plains as the chicken wing-eating public gets to decide which restaurant has the best wings in the city.

The White Plains BID and the City of White Plains are partnering to host the first ever Downtown White Plains Wing Walk. Stroll around Downtown White Plains sampling chicken wing recipes at a variety of restaurants, then vote for your favorite. There are 17 restaurants to sample from, and a whopping 40 wing flavors!

Participating restaurants include Alex Lounge Bar & Grill, Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza, The Banh Mi Shop, The Brazen Fox, Brother Jimmy's BBQ, Buffalo Wild Wings, Cantina Taco & Tequila Bar, Delicias del Jireh, Freebird Kitchen and Bar, Hudson Grille, Lazy Boy Saloon, Mario's Pizza, Ron Blacks Beer Hall, Sofrito, Sundance Kitchen & Cantina, Vintage Lounge & Restaurant, and Wolf & Warrior Brewing Company.

Please note there are FOUR check-in locations for the Downtown White Plains Wing Walk. All ticket holders must check in at one of the locations before beginning the stroll to pick up their wristband, ballot, and map. You will not be able to sample wings without a wristband. Guests must sample more than one wing flavor in order to cast their vote. All votes must be received by 5:15 PM on Saturday, April 6. There will be a press event at the winning location on Tuesday, April 9 at 2:00 PM.
