SEPTEMBER 11 TRIBUTE

White Plains, NY – September 3, 2019. As we prepare to remember those who lost their lives and worked to help others, Mayor Tom Roach, the Recreation & Parks Department and the Personnel Department announce the annual events that pay tribute to and honor the victims and heroes of September 11, 2001.

On Wednesday, September 11th, six American flags will fly from City Hall as homage to the residents of White Plains who gave their lives. A Remembrance Ceremony will be held at 8:00 a.m. at Liberty Park on Lake Street, the permanent memorial site for these residents. The ceremony will include a flag rising, wreath laying, prayer, reflections and reminiscences of this historic day in history.

On Thursday, September 12th our Personnel Department and the American Red Cross will provide residents an opportunity to roll up their sleeves and give blood. The Blood Drive will be held at City Hall, 255 Main Street in White Plains, from 10:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Donating just one pint of blood can save up to three lives and is a wonderful way to give back.
