



DO'S AND DON'TS OF ACCESSIBLE PARKING

DO

Check that your permit has not expired and is visible to the Parking Enforcement Officer

DON'T

Park or stop in an accessible parking space without an authorized permit or license plate, even for a short time

DO

Only park in an accessible parking space if the person who was issued the permit is in the vehicle

DON'T

Park in an accessible space if the person who was issued the permit will not be leaving the car

DO

Be conscientious and considerate of disabled persons who require accessible parking
