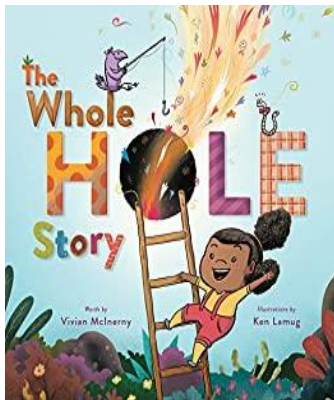

**NEW STORY IS UP NOW AT THE BRYANT-MAMARONECK
PARK STORY WALK**



White Plains, NY, July 15, 2021. Summer time is here and a new story on the Bryant-Mamaroneck Park *StoryWalk* has been selected. *The Whole Hole Story* by Vivian McInerney. Zia is used to the hole in her pocket—she frequently fills it with frogs and other objects. And as it gets bigger and bigger, she starts to wonder what might happen . . . if she fell right through. Would she cover it with a blanket to catch an elephant, or dig a tunnel to the other side of the world? The possibilities are endless, and readers will love following Zia’s adventurous imagination from beginning to end.
