**MAYOR ROACH & HOSPITAL FOR SPECIAL SURGERY TO CUT
RIBBON ON NEW SCOREBOARD
AT EBERSOLE ICE RINK**
Thursday, January 13th @ 4:45 PM

White Plains, NY – January 10, 2022. White Plains Mayor Tom Roach and Dr. Warren Young, Co-Medical Director, Dr. Seth Jerabek, Co-Medical Director and Zoi Easley, Regional Director from Hospital for Special Surgery (HSS) – Westchester will unveil the new hockey scoreboard recently installed at the Ebersole Ice Rink at Delfino Park on Thursday, January 13th at 4:45 pm. The scoreboard will be put to use immediately, as the ribbon cutting will be followed by the White Plains High School vs. North Rockland hockey match.

The acquisition of this new scoreboard has been made possible as a result of a generous donation from Hospital for Special Surgery, whose Westchester location is 1133 Westchester Avenue in White Plains. The new scoreboard replaces the old model, which was over 20 years old. The scoreboard is very visible and the general public will be able to view it at public skating sessions.

“I’d like to thank Hospital for Special Surgery for this generous contribution,” said Mayor Roach. “Ebersole Ice Rink is one of our most popular and heavily utilized community facilities and the new scoreboard will improve the visitor and team experience at the Rink for years to come.”

The scoreboard is 12 feet by 8 feet and has a black background with large 18 inch high intensity Red LED Digits which are controlled remotely. This new, state-of-the-art fixture ensures that Ebersole Ice Rink will continue its long tradition of hosting hockey games and tournaments for the White Plains Plainsmen and remain the home rink for the White Plains High School and Archbishop Stepinac Hockey teams.
