**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:** Performs complex professional engineering work associated with reviewing plans for building construction; does related work as required.

**MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:** Either:

- A) Master's Degree\* in structural, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, fire protection, architectural engineering or civil engineering and three (3) years of post-graduate experience in a related field of study, two (2) years of which must have involved the application of the NYS Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Codes/ICC Codes; or
- B) Bachelor's Degree\* in structural, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, fire protection, architectural engineering or civil engineering and four (4) years of post-graduate experience in a related field of study, two (2) years of which must have involved the application of the NYS Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Codes/ICC Codes; or
- C) A satisfactory equivalent combination of the foregoing training and experience.

**\*NOTE:** Your degree must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency. **SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:**

- 1) Possession of a Professional Engineering license from the State of New York, or obtain Engineering License through reciprocity with another state within one year of appointment.
- 2) Possession of a valid license to operate a motor vehicle in the State of New York.
- 3) Must possess or secure certification as a Code Enforcement Officer as per the requirements set by NYCRR by the end of the probationary period in order to qualify for permanent appointment.
